- Two \$250 scholarships will be awarded, one for “Junior” youth (4-H Age 8-12) and one for “Senior” youth (4-H Age 13-18).
- Youth must be registered for the 2025 Beaufort County 4-H Livestock Show & Sale to be eligible for the scholarship.
- If youth are awarded a scholarship and do not participate in the livestock show for any reason, they will not be eligible to apply in future years.
- Livestock scholarship recipients will be announced by January 24, 2025.
